B.	Arahan Am Peperiksaan:	
B.1	Calon mesti berada di bilik atau ruangan khas yang tidak ada orang lain bersama calon. Tempat awam seperti <i>cybercafe</i> , <i>restoran</i> , makmal komputer, dan sebagainya tidak dibenarkan.	
B.2	Calon perlu memastikan komputer yang digunakan mematuhi spesifikasi yang ditetapkan oleh Majlis Peperiksaan Malaysia (MPM) (sila rujuk Aplikasi dan Spesifikasi Komputer pada Bahagian A).	
B.3	Calon hendaklah berpakaian sopan atau bersesuaian semasa menduduki peperiksaan ini. MPM akan mengaktifkan mod rakaman sepanjang berlangsungnya peperiksaan ini. MPM berhak untuk menggunakan rakaman tersebut atas urusan rasmi dan kes-kes khas.	
B.4	Calon perlu berada di dalam talian pengawasan dalam aplikasi Zoom 1 jam sebelum kertas peperiksaan bermula untuk semakan kehadiran dan taklimat pengendalian peperiksaan.	
B.5	Calon hendaklah menggunakan nama sebenar seperti pada slip pendaftaran MedEx (MedEx/D) pada ruangan ' Name ' pada aplikasi Zoom.	
B.6	Calon hendaklah menggunakan latar belakang tempat yang sebenar dan dilarang menggunakan virtual/blurred background semasa berada dalam talian aplikasi Zoom sepanjang berlangsungnya peperiksaan ini.	
	PERINGATAN: CALON YANG GAGAL/TIDAK MENGAKTIFKAN BUTANG KAMERA PADA APLIKASI ZOOM SEMASA MENDUDUKI PEPERIKSAAN MedEx AKAN MENYEBABKAN KEPUTUSAN PEPERIKSAAN CALON DIBATALKAN.	
B.7	Calon digalakkan untuk menggunakan alat pendengaran (headphone/earphone) ketika mendengar rakaman Taklimat Keselamatan Peperiksaan dan Prosedur Peperiksaan Secara Dalam Talian daripada Pengawas Peperiksaan.	
B.8	Calon mesti membawa kad pengenalan atau passport semasa menduduki peperiksaan. Calon perlu mempamerkan kad pengenalan atau passport di sebelah kanan muka calon dalam tempoh masa selama 30 saat apabila diarahkan oleh Pengawas Peperiksaan. (Ini bagi tujuan merakamkan gambar calon). Calon yang gagal mempamerkan kad pengenalan atau passport apabila diminta berbuat demikian oleh Pengawas Peperiksaan akan dihalang daripada mengakses sistem peperiksaan MedEx.	
B.9	Calon dikehendaki memusingkan kamera (360 darjah) untuk menunjukkan keadaan sekeliling bilik peperiksaan (<i>surrounding check</i>) bagi memastikan tiada orang lain bersama calon.

B.10	Calon dikehendaki untuk log in ke sistem peperiksaan MedEx selepas selesai mendengar Taklimat Keselamatan Peperiksaan dan Prosedur Peperiksaan Secara Dalam Talian, iaitu 15 minit sebelum peperiksaan bermula . Pautan sistem peperiksaan MedEx dan maklumat ' Username ' serta ' Password ' akan diberikan kepada calon melalui slip MedEx/D dua minggu sebelum tarikh peperiksaan bermula.
	PERINGATAN: SISTEM PEPERIKSAAN MEDEX HANYA AKAN DIAKTIFKAN 15 MINIT SEBELUM WAKTU PEPERIKSAAN BERMULA.
B.11	Calon dikehendaki untuk membaca arahan soalan yang dipaparkan di skrin komputer dengan teliti sebelum menjawab soalan.
B.12	Calon tidak akan dibenarkan untuk mengakses sistem peperiksaan MedEx selepas 30 minit peperiksaan bermula.
B.13	Calon yang mengalami gangguan talian internet semasa peperiksaan sehingga tamat waktu peperiksaan bagi kertas yang diambil dikehendaki membuat laporan melalui emel di medex@mpm.edu.my dalam tempoh 24 jam dari waktu peperiksaan berakhir. Calon dikehendaki mengemukakan bukti sokongan bersama laporan tersebut untuk pertimbangan/keputusan.
B.14	Calon yang dapat meneruskan peperiksaan selepas gangguan talian internet itu dapat diatasi tidak akan diberikan tambahan masa. PART.	CONTENT	
B.	GENERAL EXAMINATION INTRUCTIONS:	
B.1	Candidates must be in a room or designated space alone. Public space including cybercafe, restaurant, computer laboratory, and others are not allowed.	
B.2	Candidates must ensure the computer used adheres to the specifications set by the Malaysian Examinations Council (MEC) (Kindly refer to the Computer Applications and Specifications, Part A)	
B.3	Candidates are required to be dressed appropriately when sitting for this examination. MEC will be recording the session throughout the examination. MEC has the rights to use the recording for official purposes and special cases.	
B.4	Candidates are required to log in to the proctored Zoom link 1 hour before the examination starts for the attendance verification and examination briefing.	
B.5	Candidates are required to use their real name as stated in their registration slip (MedEx/D) in the 'Name' column on Zoom.	
B.6	Candidates are required to use their actual background and are prohibited from using any virtual/blurred backgrounds on Zoom throughout the examination.	
	REMINDER: THE RESULTS WILL BE BARRED IF CANDIDATES FAIL/DO NOT ACTIVATE THE CAMERA BUTTON ON THE ZOOM APPLICATION WHEN SITTING FOR THE EXAMINATION.	
B.7	Candidates are recommended to use listening devices (headphone/earphone) when listening to the Examination Safety Briefing and Online Examination Procedure recordings by the Examination Proctor.	
B.8	Candidates must bring their identification card or passport when sitting for the examination. Candidates are required to present their identification card or passport at the right side of their face for 30 seconds when instructed by the Examination Proctor.(This is to record the candidate's picture). Candidates who fail to present their identification card or passport when instructed by the Examination Proctor will be barred from accessing the MedEx examination system.	
B.9	Candidates will be required to turn their camera (360 degrees) to show the surrounding of their examination room (surrounding verification) to ensure the absence of other people with the candidate.	

PART.	CONTENT	
B.10	Candidates are required to log in to the MedEx examination system once the Examination Safety Briefing and Online Examination Procedure is settled, which is 15 minutes before the examination starts . The MedEx examination system link and ' Username ' as well as ' Password ' will be given to the candidates via the examination registration slip (MedEx/D) two weeks before the start of the examination .	
	REMINDER: THE MEDEX EXAMINATION SYSTEM WILL ONLY BE ACTIVATED 15 MINUTES BEFORE THE EXAMINATION BEGINS.	
B.11	Candidates are required to read the questions' instructions on the computer screen carefully before answering the question.	
B.12	Candidates will not be allowed to access the MedEx examination system 30 minutes after the examination has started.	
B.13	Candidates who experience internet connectivity issues during the examination until the end of the examination for the paper are required to send a report via email to medex@mpm.edu.my within 24 hours from the end of the examination. Candidates are required to submit supporting proof/evidence together with the report for any further consideration/decision.	
B.14	Candidates who are able to continue with the examination after the internet connectivity issue has been settled will not be given any additional time. However, candidates may send their report via email to medex@mpm.edu.my within 24 hours from the end of the examination. Candidates are required to submit supporting proof/evidence together with the report for any further consideration/decision.
