Selection Criteria for entrance into the Master of Public Health Programme

Below are the minimum requirements. Candidates must:

- be registered for medical practice by the Malaysian Medical Council (MMC) under the Medical (Amendment) Act 2012 and Medical Regulations 2017.
 - Non-Malaysian candidates must obtain a Temporary Practicing Certificate from MMC.
- 2. achieve an acceptable level of English proficiency as defined by each university.
- 3. attained at least ONE (1) year of public health-related experience.
- 4. pass the Medical Specialist Pre-entrance Examination (MedEx) with a minimum grade defined by the Conjoint Board of Public Health.
- 5. pass the assessment process conducted by the Conjoint Board of Public Health.
