Selection Criteria for the Master of Anaesthesiology Programme

For admission as a trainee, the applicant shall:

- 1. Have the degree of Bachelor of Medicine and Bachelor of Surgery or equivalent qualifications approved by the Universities' Senates;
- 2. Be registrable for medical practice under the Medical Act of Malaysia; and
- 3. Have at least one year of post-registration clinical experience in anaesthesiology, to develop basic competence in patient evaluation, preparation, planning and conduct of anaesthesia care in ASA 1 and 2 patients, perform basic airway management, monitor patients for peri-procedural care, provide peri-procedural analgesia, manage life-threats and prevent harm to patients.
- 4. Have satisfactory knowledge of basic physiology, common drugs used in anaesthesia, intensive care and pain medicine; and their potential interactions, demonstrated in an Entrance Multiple Choice Questions (MCQs) Assessment. The MCQs is a 60-question paper over 90 minutes, comprising 30 physiology and 30 pharmacology questions.
- 5. Fulfil the universities' English language proficiency criteria.
- 6. Fulfil the criteria set by their sponsoring body, e.g. Ministry of Health, Universities.

Candidates' entrance to the programme is subject to the Specialty Conjoint Board evaluation decision.
